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## **WHEN AND WHERE IS THE EVENT?**

DEFEAT DELAMERE takes place on Sunday, 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2024. The event will be held at Delamere Forest.

09:30 – 10 Miler

10:00 – 10km

10:30 – 5km

11:30 – Mini Miler

The event will finish approximately at 13:00.

## **HOW CAN I GET THERE?**

We recommend travelling by car.

Car Parking is available at Delamere Forest. There will be a small charge of £3 for those utilising the car park areas. Please ensure that you gain the exclusive event code from Roy Castle staff. Payments can be made by cash or card at the onsite pay machines. Please use the main Visitor Centre Car Park - adjacent to the central facilities. There are a number of accessible parking spaces.

## **WHAT IS THE ROUTE?**

All distances are run on mixed terrains that include gravel and trail paths.

Some areas of the course may become slightly muddy after trees have recently been cut down. The route will be sign posted and marshalled so all you need to do is follow the signs and enjoy all that the forest has to offer.

## **WHERE IS THE START AND FINISH LINE?**

The event site is 2 minutes walk from the car park area. Head straight for the visitor centre and café then, you'll see the event site straight ahead.

Look out for any Roy Castle staff wearing blue tops, they will assist with any queries.

## **HOW DO I COLLECT MY RACE NUMBER?**

Registration will open at 08:30. Please ensure that you arrive on time for the event if you arrive after the allotted time frame you will be unable to take part as we are on a strict schedule and no refund will be issued.

Yes. Entries on the day are available at the set price of £10-£40 and can be purchased from the Registration desk, this is subject to availability and the capacity of the event.

## **CAN I BRING AN ANIMAL WITH ME ON THE DAY?**

We do allow dogs on the DEFEAT DELAMERE course however, they must wear a lead at all times.

## **IS THERE A BAGGAGE DROP?**

There is a baggage drop located near the Registration desk, the location will be signposted when you arrive on site.

## **IS THERE MEDICAL AID AT THE EVENT?**

There will be medical aid available to all runners, this will be provided by Urgent Care North West.

## **WHERE ARE THE TOILETS LOCATED?**

The toilets are located near the Visitor Centre and café.  
The toilets will be clearly signed posted.

## **WHERE WILL THE PHOTOS FROM THE EVENT BE POSTED?**

We will post our race photos to our DEFEAT DELAMERE Event page shortly after the event has concluded.
